Knowing your MPs

Websites provide detailed information about MPs, including their contact information, bios, and parliamentary performance.





Lok Sabha is elected by an election on the basis of adult franchise envisaged by the Constitution. The members to represent the States and Territories and the Union Territories are nominated by the State Legislative Assemblies adequately represented in the Lok Sabha. (One Hundred and Twenty-five members) nomination has not been extended further. 
